

Fremantle Moving Guide: Local Relocation Tips & Services

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Fremantle's mix of heritage cottages, converted warehouses and modern apartments near the port gives it a character all its own — and a few things worth knowing if you're moving in, out, or around the area.

What to Know Before You Move

Many Fremantle homes are heritage-listed cottages with narrow doorways, tight staircases and small courtyards — all things your removalist should know about ahead of time so they bring the right equipment and crew size. If you're moving into one of the newer apartment developments near the harbour, check building access and loading arrangements in advance.

Local Moving Tips

- **Narrow streets** — Fremantle's older neighbourhoods can have limited truck access, so confirm your removalist has a plan for streets that don't allow a large vehicle to park directly outside - **Coastal weather** — Fremantle's sea breeze (the "Freo Doctor") picks up most afternoons, so scheduling loading and unloading around calmer morning hours can help, especially with larger furniture items - **Protect original features** — heritage homes often have original timber floors or door frames; floor protection and careful handling around doorways matters more here than in newer builds

Choosing a Local Removalist

Ask whether your removalist has experience with Fremantle's heritage properties specifically — navigating a narrow Victorian-era hallway is a different skill to moving furniture through a modern apartment lobby. Confirm AFRA accreditation and that police-checked staff are handling your move directly.

Packing Fragile Items

If you're moving glass, marble or artwork, ask how these are individually wrapped for protection — particularly important given the tighter manoeuvring often required in Fremantle's older homes.

Making Moving Day Easier

A Fremantle move, whether local or the start of a longer journey, deserves a removalist who understands the area's unique housing stock. Get a clear, written quote and ask the right questions about access and experience before booking.
