Why People Need Mid-Move Storage

****Timing Misalignment**** You've sold your old home but settlement on the new one isn't for another 3 weeks. Staying with friends is temporary; living in a hotel for a month is expensive. Short-term storage solves this.

****Renovation or Construction Delays**** Your new home isn't quite ready. Storage holds your belongings safely while builders finish work.

****Downsize or Upsize Gradually**** Moving from a large house to an apartment? Store furniture you can't fit immediately. Decide later whether to sell, donate, or move it to permanent storage.

****International or Interstate Moves**** Your new country or state requires shipping timelines you can't control. Fragile stores your items domestically while international logistics arrange final delivery.

****Estate Transitions**** After a loss, family members need time to sort and divide items respectfully. Secure storage provides breathing room without the pressure to decide everything at once.

Storage Duration: What to Budget

- ****1–2 weeks****: Quick bridge between moves (most common) - ****1–3 months****: Renovation waiting, sale settlement delays - ****3–6 months****: Major downsizing, international move prep - ****6+ months****: Long-term storage (less common for removals, more for antiques or seasonal items)

Types of Storage: Which Fits Your Move?

1. Climate-Controlled Vault Storage ****Best for****: artwork, electronics, furniture, vintage items, wine collections - Maintains stable temperature & humidity - Deters pest damage and mold - Higher cost per month - Ideal if items are valuable or sensitive

2. Standard Containers (Non-Climate-Controlled) ****Best for****: everyday furniture, boxes of textiles, kitchenware - Lower monthly cost - Good for short-term (1–3 months) - Suitable for most household items - Adequate weather protection in Australian conditions

3. Self-Access Storage Units ****Best for****: frequent access needs, tools, hobby equipment - You pack and retrieve items yourself - Lower labor cost - Hourly or daily access fees apply - Not ideal if you need items moved carefully

Insurance During Storage

Your household insurance may ***not*** cover items in external storage. Options: 1. Add a "storage rider" to your existing policy (£10–30/month typically) 2. Fragile's optional storage insurance (item-based, recommended for valuables) 3. Self-insure (risky, only for low-value items)

Always declare what you're storing for insurance purposes.

Do's & Don'ts for Stored Items

****DO****: - Photograph items before storage (proof of condition) - Keep a detailed inventory list - Store items in boxes (not loose on the floor) - Leave fragile items clearly marked - Use moisture absorbers in humid climates - Keep access documentation handy

****DON'T****: - Store items that require regular use (daily clothes, medications) - Pack items without labeling - Store perishables or hazardous materials - Store live animals or plants - Assume your household insurance covers external storage - Forget to schedule final retrieval in advance

Timeline: Storage & Move Coordination

****Week 1****: Move inventory items → pack with Fragile → load to vault ****Week 2–4****: Finalize new home details; confirm final delivery date ****Final week****: Schedule unload; arrange new home access; confirm delivery time ****Delivery day****: items unloaded to final destination

When NOT to Use Storage

- ****Very short moves**** (< 2 days): direct removal is cheaper - ****International moves****: customs and shipping delays often require professional consolidation (different from domestic storage) -

****Temporary item overflow****: renting a casual self-storage unit may be more flexible

Real Scenario: First-Time Buyer's Storage

Alex bought her first apartment but settlement wasn't for 6 weeks. Her lease ended in 2 weeks. Fragile moved her into a 3-month climate-controlled unit (\$750 total).
